## REMEMBER TO VOTE

Washington County Elections officials say ballots should be mailed by Thursday, Oct. 30 to make sure they are received by the 8pm Nov. 4 election deadline.

Voters can also drop their ballots off at official drop sites located at:

**Ballots can also be dropped off at school.** Voters can also drop their ballots off at any Tigard-Tualatin school office. Ballots received at the schools will be delivered to official ballot drop sites before the election deadline.

## Caring Closet

The Caring Community Closet help children by giving:

- Gently used school clothing and coats

To schedule an appointment, the school must refer a child. The counselors or staff that work at your child's school can make referrals. The counselor or staff will e-mail the Caring Closet and provide student name and phone number with the referral. If a family has children in more than one school, a referral from one school will cover all students in the family. The Caring Closet will contact families to make a personal shopping appointment.

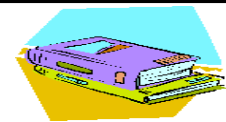
## Winter Weather is Coming
