## ¡Saludos desde C.F.T.!

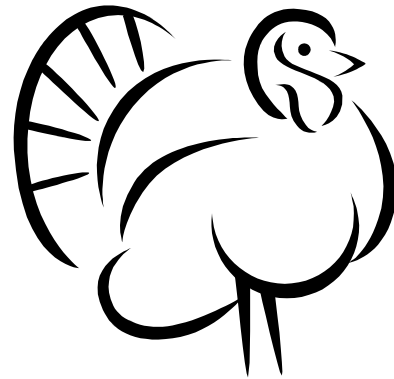
