Last night (Tuesday night) was especially exciting because we started purchasing technology for the classrooms. A high priority need for our teachers this year is for document cameras. Three cameras were approved to be purchased in our meeting. Document cameras are a cross between an overhead projector, an opaque projector, and a digital camera. Teachers can project onto a screen anything from book pages, worksheets, writing, rocks, money, truly...anything! Then you can zoom in, take digital pictures or have students manipulate what is under the camera. Further, you can zoom in and out and even take digital pictures. The sky is the limit for this technology. It also eliminates the need to make expensive transparencies for the old overhead projectors.

I share all this with you because I believe it is important for you to know that when you give to a jog-a-thon or an auction, the money makes it to the classrooms. Our parents attending the PSO meetings are great stewards of your generous donations and will continue to make great decisions that benefit our kids in the classroom.
