Immunizations

Please remember to update your student's immunization records! If you received a letter stating your child needs a vaccine, please update the office as soon as possible. Statewide exclusion day is rapidly approaching!

Flu Reminder:



Flu season is here! If your student hasn't been immunized against the flu, please consider the vaccine. Flu symptoms include high fever, aches, tiredness, upper respiratory symptoms and for some children, nausea and vomiting (usually not a symptom in adults). If your student comes down with a fever please keep him/her home until he/she has been fever free for 24 hours without medication. Practice good hand washing and remember not to share cups, glasses or silverware! Cough and sneeze into your sleeves, clean surfaces and get lots of rest, good exercise and eat and drink healthy foods.
