

Tips on Signing up your School/Non-Profit w/ Moolala

With all the of interest in getting schools and non-profits signed up on Moolala, here is a couple more tips to make start up easy!

Go to: www.scripcenter.moolala.com t

A). An individual can sign up their non-profit at www.scripcenter.moolala.com using a personal email address. I would suggest that under the "name" section of the sign up they use their non-profits name. Once signed up, they can assign the non-profit name as the account "username", to create the link they will send to parents, members, supporters, staff, etc. www.ABCSchool.moolala.com or www.UnitedChurch.moolala.com, www.Portlanddance.moolala.com, etc.

The next step is to have the person who signed up the non-profit then sign up as an individual too underneath the non-profit. If they do not have another email account they can use, I would suggest getting a free email account at google.com, for example janedoe@gmail.com. They can then use this email address and their personal name to become a member underneath their non-profit.

B). Just like the example above, if they do not have their non-profits email address, they can create one on google.com., for example ABCSchool@gmail.com or UnitedChurch@gmail.com, etc. They can then go to www.scripcenter.moolala.com and use this email to sign up their non-profit. Under the name section, use the non-profits name and use the gmail email address.

Then, they can sign up under their non-profit as an individual using their personal email address, name, etc.

If any one has a sign up issue, the Customer Service Team at Moolala is simply wonderful---look for the bright orange "Get Help" tab on all Moolala web pages on the right hand side.
