As many of you have heard by now I will not be returning to Tualatin Elementary in the fall. This has been a really difficult decision for me because I absolutely love my job, this school, this staff and most of all, your kids! We have accomplished a lot together over the last two years and I know that this team will continue to give everything they have to educating your children. The new principal should be announced before the end of the school year. I will miss Tualatin Elementary so much!

But, before I leave we have an exciting event happening at our school on June 3rd at 9:30 a.m. Susan Castillo, the Superintendent of Instruction for the State of Oregon, will be visiting our school to celebrate winning the Student Success Champion Award this year. Mayor Lou Ogdon, TTSD Superintendent Saxton and other local dignitaries will be joining us at this event. We are looking forward to celebrating our school on this day!

We have finished our state testing and our school scores look great. I am proud to say that on average across grades 3-5, 90% met or exceeded the state benchmark in reading and 75% met in math. The math scores aren't as high this year because the benchmark score was raised, but compared to the district and the state our scores look really strong. Our teachers and students have worked very hard this year. Congratulations!

We will also continue to watch our garden grow. If you are interested in adopting the garden for a week over the summer please look for the sign-up sheet on the Garden Bulletin Board in the entry way of our school. You will be able to keep all harvested vegetables from the garden.

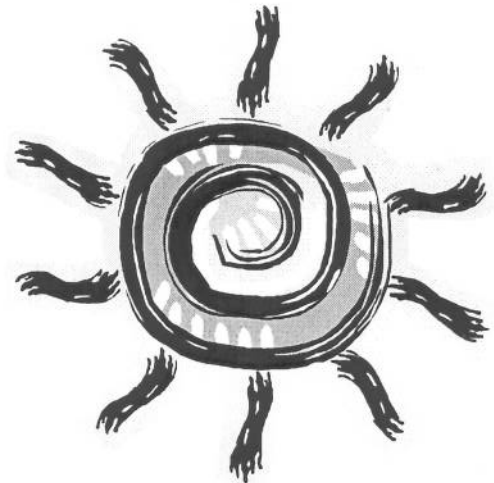
Attention All Tualatin Racers!!!

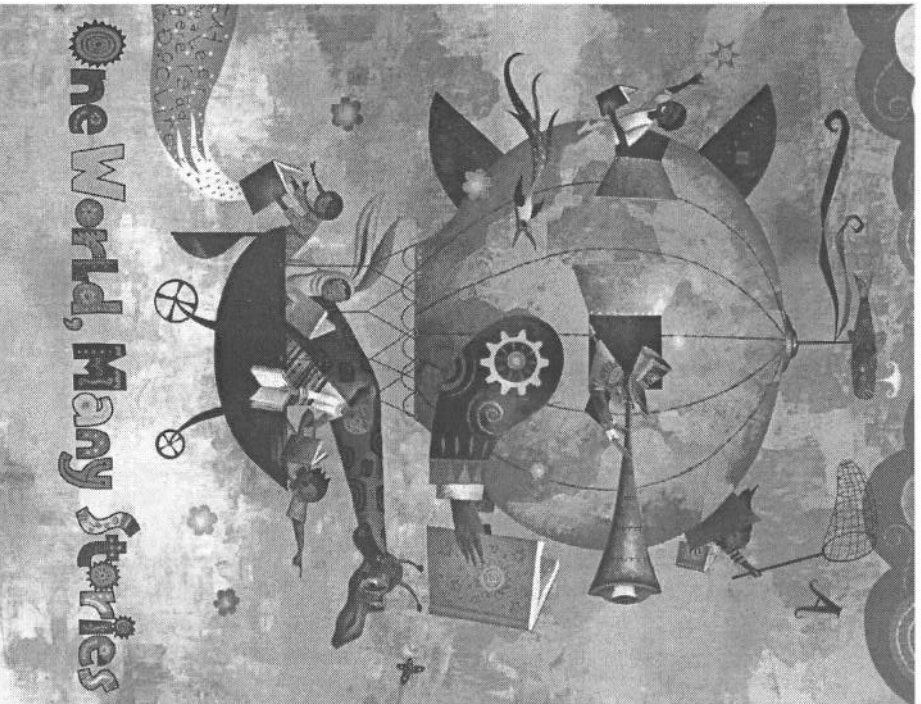
