

## **Band and Orchestra Boosters Board Meeting Tuesday, October 6, 2009**

**Present:** Tiffany Mitton, Dawn Klavinski-Stell, Laura Baker, Jean Wisner, Debee Wilson, Brandon VanDyke, Bev Colisch (arrived later)

Meeting called to order at 7:10 p.m.

### **Secretary's Report** (Laura Baker)

Laura Baker provided minutes from the last Board meeting and they were approved unanimously.

### **Fundraising Coordinator's Report** (Debee Wilson)

- Poinsettias: Debee reported that students were in attendance at Back-to-School nights at both Byrom Elementary and TuHS to sell poinsettias with good results. October 8<sup>th</sup> is the deadline for all students to return poinsettia order forms to Mr. Van Dyke.
- Wolves: One wolf was sold at the Back-to-School nights. Brainstorming was done for continuing wolf sales and the Board suggested that fall-decorated wolves be offered for sale at the Orchestra concert on October 20.
- Timberwolves Wristbands: The order has been placed and the wristbands should be here in time for Homecoming. Debee reported that there is a Timberfest event on October 16 before the Homecoming game and this may be a venue for selling the wristbands. Laura Baker provided contact information for the student Timberfest coordinator and Debee will contact her. After Board discussion, the sale price for the wristbands was set at \$2.
- Fred Meyer Grant: Dawn Klavinski-Stell reported on the Fred Meyer donation program. She is an employee and can't apply herself, but provided details and contact information about the program, which is geared toward youth and hunger issues. The Board suggested applying for funds for clinicians and scholarships for private music lessons for students and Tiffany and/or Debee will follow up.
- Kaady Car Wash Fundraiser: Dawn also had information about a ticket sales fundraiser for Kaady Car Wash. The company offers multi-pack tickets to organizations which they sell for \$24, and one-third of that sale price is kept by the organization.

### **Band Director's Report** (Brandon VanDyke)

- Pep Band Schedule: The basketball schedule is out now and with double-header games, each pep band group will play 4 nights, but 5 games.
- Tee-Shirts: Brandon reported that there was a small change made in the tee-shirt design—TuHS band logo on the sleeve—which increased the production price slightly. The money for the tee-shirts has already been collected and so this may create a small shortfall, but there are extra shirts to sell which could offset this.
- Trip: Trip forms are coming in from students and all but 4 Wind Ensemble and 9 Orchestra musicians have indicated that they are interested in the trip this year. Brandon said that he could follow-up with parents if he doesn't receive forms back from these students.

**Volunteer Coordinator's Report** (Jean Wiser): Volunteer sign-ups are looking good in general for October. Jean reports that she will need two volunteers for the snack shack on October 20 and two table attendants for the Orchestra concert on the same night.

**Treasurer's Report** (Bev Colisch): Bev reported that there had been no financial activity (deposits or checks written) since the last meeting.
