

Scrip Individual Account Agreement

As a result of a district-level review of the uses of individual Scrip accounts, we have better defined the approved uses of student accounts. Please read the approved expenditure list below, as well as the transfer policy, sign and return with your first Scrip order. ***Scrip profits will not be allocated to your student's individual account without an agreement signed by a parent/guardian on file.*** Approved expenditures are listed by program, because of the potential for transfer of account balance from one program to another within the TSO Scrip program.

Band/Orchestra program (Music): required “uniforms” for performances (pep band shirts, required blouses/shirts and bow ties, uniform skirts) solo/ensemble fee, WIBC fees and All NW contest fees, the bundled expense of the bi-annual band/orchestra trip, group travel to TuHS band outings, any required clothing rental for performances. Please note that private lessons are no longer reimbursable. TuHS Band Boosters Exec Committee retains the authority to approve any other request for reimbursement based on the Internal Revenue Code provisions for tax-exempt organizations.

Choir: bundled fee for official choir trip, Treble choir and Crimsonnaire dresses, Crimsonnaire retreat, solo/ensemble, state, All NW entry fees and any other approved expenses paid through TuHS Choir.

IB Program: Exam fees.

Drama: school sponsored trips, including local field trips, acting competition fees, TuHS theater troupe membership fee, costume fees for plays if donated to school after performance.

Baseball, Dance, Cheerleading, Snowboarding: school sponsored trips, competitions, uniforms.

Transfer of Individual Balances: If your student ceases to participate in one of the programs, there are three options for his/her account balance:

- Transfer balance to another individual account program (for the same student) within the TSO Scrip program (i.e. Dance to Choir) – ***note***, Band accounts cannot be transferred due to the specific tax-exempt purpose of the Band Boosters group.
- Transfer account balance to a sibling already in TuHS or enrolling in the following year.
- Transfer balance to general fund account of the program in which the student no longer participates.

Earned scrip funds are the property of Tualatin High School and can be transferred from individual accounts to a designated scrip fund. Individual reimbursement checks will not be issued. (*Exception is Band/Orchestra accounts which operate separately from the school scrip account through the Band Boosters group*).
