Principal's Report- Darin Barnard

- Currently there are 1920 students enrolled.
- 2nd period classes have highest enrollment. Since school started we have already added .5 teacher back. We will be adding another .5 Science teacher back which will add 3 sections of science. Still need to evaluate what sections.
- Promoting the "Tualatin Way" in Freshman Global Perspectives classes and to staff.
- Offering 3 leadership classes this semester (about 120 students). Students will be encouraged to get involved. There will be more opportunities for students to have leadership roles.
- Parent volunteers are really stepping up; additional help is still needed especially in the library, counseling office and copy room.
- Readerboard is installed! Waiting for software installation before it will work. Hopefully soon.
- 2012-13- Open enrollment throughout the state. Students can opt to attend any open school throughout the state.
- Roof is scheduled to be replaced next year
- The district has spent \$2.5 million of its \$10million technology/science portion of the bond. All HS teachers received new Macbooks. Teachers' old computers are used elsewhere in school.
