Aug 31- \$43658.98 on hand, in three different accounts (checking, money market and Scrip.) This also includes \$10000 that was donated for a new reader board. The TSO approved dedicating an additional \$3000 last school year included with the \$10,000 in accrued liabilities

The 2010/11 budget was presented. A motion was made to adopt the budget, motion seconded, passed.

A motion was made to approve the fall grants for \$20,000. Motion was seconded, passed.

Before school started, local church volunteers and some teachers participated in a fall clean up and flower planting. Flowers were donated by Al's Garden Center. Focusing on taking pride in both the school and the building. Would like to hold clean ups throughout the year (Spring, before summer and fall, before school starts) and get both staff and students more involved. Staff spent time team building the week before school started. Reinforced the messages to "Put kids first" and "Make every minute of class count."
