Treasurer's Report: Bev Colisch

Current Assets \$26117.33 We have \$19458.03 in checking, and \$3282.13 in our money market account. School directories have made \$190 profit. \$210.00 from bricks for Grad Night.

Principal's Report: Darin Barnard

S3 Recommendations will be out later in Feb. Superintendent Rob Saxton will meet with all schools soon, to go over the cuts to their budgets, at 5%, 10%, and 15%, (which is really 20% at the high School level.)

*91% of the budget at TuHS is salaries.

*15% cuts= 8-18 teachers

*The district is considering a schedule change from A, B days with the block schedule to 7 periods a day.

*Between the 2 high schools, we are looking at cutting 39 teachers, 15 classified positions, and 1.5 admin.

*The district is still negotiating teacher contracts.

*Conferences have been change to Mon and Wed. the 14th and 16th. The teachers will have an in-service day on Thursday, and a Friday off.

Old Business:

Kathy Stallkamp reported the reader board is progressing but additional funds are still needed to complete the project. A neighborhood meeting was held to discuss the reader board with neighbors that live within 1000ft of TuHS. We are requesting that the city change the codes, rather than re-zoning which will eliminate the need for engineering studies. It was suggested that the bricks on the base of the sign be purchased and engraved, to help off-set funds still needed to complete this project.

The Auction is coming up. Need to get the word out. Help is still needed. The auction will take place at Club Sport this year. The price is considerably less than previous years.
